Launch Contest

Official Rules & Regulations

- 1) ENTRY PERIOD: The Contest begins at 10:00am on October 19, 2022 and ends at 11:59pm on October 28, 2022.
- 2) ELIGIBILITY: You must be thirteen (13) years or older and a legal resident in the province of British Columbia (BC) to enter this Contest. City of Surrey employees and immediate family members of City of Surrey employees are not eligible to enter.

3) HOW TO ENTER: You may enter by:

- O tagging a friend on the Contest post located on the Surrey Tree Lighting Festival Facebook page; OR
- O by following both the @surreybcevents AND @shopgtc Instagram accounts PLUS tagging a friend on the Contest post located on the @surreybcevents Instagram.

You will receive one (1) entry for every tag made in the manner described above. Unlimited entries are allowed.

- 4) ENTRY GUIDELINES: Late or corrupt entries will not be accepted. Your entries must not be obscene or otherwise inappropriate, as determined by the City of Surrey in its sole discretion. Entries that are deemed inappropriate will not be accepted.
- 5) PRIZES: There will be two (2) Grand Prize Winners. Each Winner will receive a gift card to Tim Hortons having a face value of \$100, plus \$50 in tickets that may be used at the food trucks located at the Tree Lighting Festival event on November 19, 2022, plus one (1) Guildford Town Centre gift card having a face value of \$50. The Prize must be accepted as awarded and is non-transferable. No substitution of the Prize is permitted. The Prize cannot be returned for a cash refund.
- 6) WINNERS AND ODDS: Two (2) Prize Winners will be drawn after October 28, 2022, but before November 19, 2022, from all eligible entries received.
